

# Know Before You Go

Penrose Heritage Museum, 11 Lake Circle, Colorado Springs, CO, 80906



Parking is available in The Broadmoor parking garage and Museum staff will validate your stay up to 90-minutes.

After parking, take the elevator to the ground floor of Broadmoor Hall. The accessible path to the Museum is through the main entrance/exit of the hall (next photo), which leads to a paved path. There is another entrance, with a short staircase, if you follow the green Exit sign on the left side of this photo.



The main entrance of Broadmoor Hall is wheelchair accessible and directly across from the large screens.



Exit to the left for a wheelchair accessible ramp to the sidewalk and proceed to the right along the sidewalk to get to the Museum.



Follow the sidewalk in front of Broadmoor Hall to the crosswalk at the Parking Garage Entrance.



Cross the crosswalk in front of the parking garage entrance/exit and the Museum is immediately to the right.



The entrance to the Museum features an automatic door opener. It is located on the right-hand side of the wall.



The staff office is to the left of a wooden check-in table. The table contains parking validations and a guestbook.



Restrooms are through the open door space on the right hand side after entering the Museum. Coat hooks can be found on the other side of the curved walls.



Museum staff may remind you to please not touch objects. The Museum has minimal barriers but for the longterm preservation of our collection, please do not touch unless in a space where you are specifically told it is ok.



Food and drink are not permitted in the Museum. Bottled water is allowed; please leave all other beverages at the front check-in table while you explore the galleries.
